How to Theorize: Moving from your research towards “theory”

26 May 2021, 17:00 – 19:00 CET on Zoom. **NB: Change in time!**

The second online *Mittelbau* meet-up provides an opportunity to meet colleagues from other universities and think about an essential step in your career: tying your individual research interests and findings to theories on a higher level of abstraction, opening up doors to new projects and international cooperation beyond your specific topic. Specifically, we have invited Ivan Strenski to discuss with us questions regarding the disciplinary nature of the study of religion: *What keeps us together? Do we have a research program, sharing general research questions?* Please note that there are two recommended readings for the presentation, which have been attached to the e-mail.

Apart from this lecture and a plenary discussion, we will have ample time for more informal conversation and exchange about the PhD/Postdoc life during a pandemic.

Ivan Strenski is Emeritus Professor of Religious Studies at the University of California, after having worked at Birmingham, Yale, and various North American universities. He is the author of 15 books, most notably *Understanding Theories of Religion: An Introduction*. Much of his work can be found [online](#).
